CATF is an umbrella organization involving several concerned groups and individuals from Marquette County. CATF provides a conduit through which ways to deal with the local impacts of climate change are disseminated, a forum where leaders of local units of government and members of the general public can come together to consider cooperative responses and seek funding for climate adaptation projects and a network of contacts with state and federal agencies that can offer local communities technical advice, research tools and access to sources of funding.

Organization Structure

CATF's members meet quarterly for committee and member updates. Members disseminate information to their organizations, but do not represent their organization in an official capacity at meetings. Seven Officers are elected annually to set meeting agendas and update the CATF Work Plan. CATF committees are created as needed to address specific projects and report their progress at quarterly meetings.
